# Summer Wine Feature

## Pacific North West

The Pacific Northwest provides such a diversity of wine, from the lush wooded regions of Western Oregon and Washington to the vast, stark steppe-shrub areas of Eastern Washington's Columbia Valley, from the fertile soils of Idaho's Snake River Valley to the wondrous lakes and hills of British Columbia's Okanagan Valley.

The Northwest's warm, dry interior regions are uniquely suited to producing full-bodied, balanced wines. In fact, such areas often receive more sunlight than competing vineyards in California. The moist, temperate climates of the Northwest's coastal region are another surprise. Areas such as the San Juan Islands, the Gulf Islands and the Olympic Peninsula have proven that the secret to producing a good wine lies not only in the length of warmth of summer weather, but in the patient hand of the vintner who can instinctively blend the right combination of soil, atmosphere and diligent attention to produce the finest wine. It is from this growing reputation for excellence that the Northwest acquires its respected standing as a New World wine region.

## Champagne / Sparkling Wine

Champagne, literally translated as 'Open Landscape', is not just any sparkling wine. It is a wine produced from three specific grape varieties: chardonnay, pinot noir and pinot meunier using the 'champagne method' from the province of the same name. Although sparkling wine is produced all over the world, it can only be called 'champagne' in this heavily regulated wine district.

## Sauvignon Blanc

White wine-makers of the Loire have traditionally followed very similar principles to their counterparts in Germany, assiduously avoiding malolactic fermentation and any new oak influence, preferring instead to ferment and store wines in inert containers, and to bottle wines early, possibly after some lees contact.

Pinot Gris is a widely disseminated vine variety that can produce soft, gently perfumed wines with more substance and color than most wines. Pinot Grigio is the common Italian name for the French vine variety Pinot Gris and, as such, is probably the name by which the variety is best known to many wine drinkers.

## Riesling

Alsace produces eight major varietal wines; riesling, gewürztraminer, pinot gris, pinot noir, pinot blanc, muscat, chasselas and sylvaner. Most wine-makers deliberately prevent malolactic fermentation in white wines by keeping them cool and lightly sulphured, preferring to keep the fresh grape aromas.
